THE CHALLENGE

As its business became more complex, WebAssign struggled to capture and monitor data using QuickBooks and never-ending spreadsheets inside of Excel. With software limitations, WebAssign lacked visibility into individual engineering projects so it could make better forecasts about the resources needed to add new product features within their business.

WebAssign initially tried to solve this challenge by moving to Microsoft Dynamics Great Plains (GP), but faced significant internal resistance due to the system's clunky timesheet interface, which created barriers for employees.

In addition to manual reporting processes, the company resorted to a paper-based timesheet approval process, which created a cumbersome paper trail for human resources and no easy way to track if everyone on the 70-person team was turning in timesheets.
